
Albemy N. Janisse Memorial Golf Tournament



TIPS FOR GRIEVING KIDS



1. Tell them honestly what happened concerning the death: when it occurred, where it happened, how the person died, who was there.
2. Encourage them to ask any questions and answer each one simply and directly.
3. Include them in the funeral or memorial planning. They need to know that they are part of this major family ritual.
4. Provide a consistent presence and structure to their daily lives.
5. Accept all of their feelings and help them express these feelings in an appropriate way.
6. Seek out other children, in a support group or alone, who have experienced the death of someone they love.
7. Share stories about loss. Read books as a springboard for discussing death... and life.
8. Reassure children that they do not have to take care of their surviving parent.
9. Clarify that they are not responsible in any way - through thoughts, feelings, or actions - for the death of their loved-one.
10. Keep telling them of your love, and hugging and touching them.
11. Reassure them that healing from loss takes a long time, but that they will feel better.
12. Mention the name of their deceased person, reminisce, tell stories.
13. Plan ahead, with their input, for holidays and special days.
14. Expect abnormal behaviour. After all, death is not an everyday occurrence.
15. Know in your heart that children become stronger and develop coping-with-life skills as they heal their grief in a healthy way.

Getting Back to Normal After the Loss of a Loved-One

Here are some ways to get back to normal. It's hard at first, but time heals and it does get better!

- **Continue Praying every night. Even though you are shocked about your loved-one's death, it is still very important to pray every night.**
- **Get back into your normal routine. This can help you deal with the death of a loved-one because it will help you get your mind off your sad feelings. When you are doing normal things, you can know that your loved-one is always with you in your heart.**
- **Do things to help you remember your loved-one, such as making a photo album or scrapbook of memories you had with that person. You can also do things such as make a DVD made up of video clips of you and your loved one; you can even make a t-shirt with a photo of your loved one on it so that they can be with you as you see the world!**



10 Reasons Children Should Be Involved in the Funeral Process

- 1) Children grieve in their own unique way. Involving your child allows them to be a part of your family's loss.
- 2) Death is a part of life. We all ways want to protect our children. Give them the necessary tools in life to understand, and how to cope with the loss.
- 3) Show your child that grieving is the way to healing. Crying is okay. Sharing your memories help you & your child through the roller coaster ride called "Grief."
- 4) Ceremony is what we do to celebrate special events in our lives. Funerals are an important way to celebrate a life loved and lived.
- 5) Assure your child that death is not "Contagious."
- 6) Allow your child to participate with the funeral service. This gives your child a sense of belonging during a very uncertain time in their life.
- 7) Remember to ask your child if they would like to attend. Let him or her make their own

decision. Never force your child to attend if they do not feel comfortable with the situation.

- 8) Encourage your child to go to the cemetery during the next year.
- 9) Answer your child's ques-

tions as honestly as possible. Our children look to us for guidance. Encourage them to share with you.

- 10) Bereaved children need to feel like their feelings **MATTER**.

Hiding death from children may result in future uncertainty and may result in negative feelings towards funerals. ❖



